Introduction

Your natal horoscope, or birth chart, is a snapshot of the heavens at the moment you were born. It shows what the sky actually looked like at the time and place of your birth. Astrology in modern times has renewed the ancient discovery that the symbolism of the planets that surrounded you at birth describes your character and personality. Planets that were directly overhead at the time and place of your birth are most important, and would appear at the very top of the chart or the Midheaven. Planets that were just rising above the horizon in the East at the time of your birth would appear near the horizontal line at the left hand side of the chart or the Ascendant. If the Sun appears in the top half of the chart, then you were born during daylight hours and have a more outer directed personality. All of these features reflect the factors at play in the Universe at the moment of your birth and are significant indications of the basic qualities and tendencies that continue to make up your personality.

Each planet's relative position in the sky and significant angles that it makes to the other planets, or aspects, are examined in this report. Please keep in mind that you are not limited by these descriptions. Your natal horoscope does not prescribe your fate. The stars incline, they do not compel. Your birth chart shows potentials that you can either struggle to fulfill or deny. The choice is yours. Beneficial aspects, or planetary positions, are areas of life in which you show natural talent and achieve easy success. Challenging aspects, or planetary positions, can become your greatest asset if you can learn to be aware of how that dynamic plays out in your life and the world at large. The strongest and most important features of your chart are described first. For definitions of astrological terms, please refer to the glossary at the end of this report.

Chart Patterns

T-Square, focal planet Chiron

Chiron in the Seventh House (or sign) represents issues with one's vital force to relate with others intimately. With this placement, you have both a tremendous desire to connect with other people, as well as frustrations that have arisen in this area. Your attempts to connect may have been

frustrated through experiences of early childhood, when you wanted contact with others but were rejected or somehow prevented from establishing meaningful relationships with them. As a consequence you have been focused on establishing such a connection ever since. It becomes extremely important to establish a connection with another person, yet this contact, so desired and even longed for, can also be extremely painful. Any partial rejection can be seen as a revisiting of your earlier pain surrounding issues of relationship to other people. As time goes on, there may even be some element of self-sabotage involved in your relationship experience. You may also become compulsively attached to the idea of close personal involvement, seeing yourself as more of a part of a desired union than as an isolated ego, "on your own". Yet your very wholeness does also depend on being able to stand independently, so that there an element of dysfunction in the way you deal with interpersonal relationships. Your path to healing these issues may be to become more fully conscious of the earlier wounding that you have experienced, enabling you to finally move through that pain toward a less fear-based way of relating, without the selfundoing or the extreme sensitivity that may have been unconsciously present. You may also find that you are able to take the conscious knowledge you have gained through this process further by helping other people deal with these same issues, either through work in the helping professions, or just with friends and loved ones in the course of your daily life. As you grow more sure of yourself, this area of interpersonal relationships, while still very important to you, can become a great source of strength for yourself and for others as well.

The following applies to your generation as a whole as well as to you personally:

Chiron in Virgo (or the Sixth House) represents issues with one's vital force of improving and organizing more efficient ways to serve self and others. With this placement you are more or less compulsively drawn to the issues of organization, and personal sickness and health, as well as service to other people. You may experience some degree of suffering through illhealth, either real or imagined, or through over-doing for others in a service role, perhaps as a member of an organization or work place. You may experience painful realizations around the possibility of perfection in this life time, such as keeping the perfect house in order at all times, so that it becomes an obsession, or the quest for the perfect body. These issues may stem from early childhood, in relation to being put in a position of servitude against your will, or challenged in your developing feelings of self-worth, so that issues of making yourself available to others become both a habit and a source of painful memories in your adult life. Or these issues may operate more at the level of the fantasy and the imagination. It is important to get as conscious as possible with these issues, to discover what actual events may have been essential to forming the constellation of your inner life. As long as these issues remain locked away in your unconscious they are basically toxic to your healthy self-image, and they backfire on you when you least expect them to, and may eventually manifest as actual ill-health. As you become more conscious of these patterns deep within you the healing can begin, enabling you to be of true service to others, as you operate from a place of joy and well-being, rather than from a place of resentment and frustration. By doing this work on yourself, you get more

clear, and you gain a truer perspective on yourself and your life's journey. As you are better able to nourish yourself with what you actually need, you are better able to help others as well.

T-Square, focal planet Pluto

Pluto in the Sixth House (or sign) gives you an intense desire to be of service in the world. This desire can take the form of a compulsion to help others in a way that may not truly be appreciated by the intended beneficiaries. You are slightly obsessed with finding the purity inherent in human activity, and may well be a champion of the environmental movement, or exert yourself strenuously in your job or home setting. You may also become intensely concerned and perhaps even chronically worried over health issues, or you may be apt to stress over organizational detail where the intention is to purify the function of the particular activity, but where attending to the details can become an end in itself. You may go through many profound changes of attitude in these areas, in order to learn how to be of actual service to yourself and others. Creative outlets for your passion might be found in the helping professions, or in working on your own issues in such a way as to regenerate your values and life direction. When you have transformed in these areas you can become a beacon for others to follow. By staying true to your own inner guidance system, you make it possible for others to also, and further the cause of a more selfaware and wisely functioning planetary society.

Your desire for personal reputation may also be thwarted, but this can lead to benefits for you, by forcing you to re-evaluate your need to achieve. Transformation in this area is guite possible, as you learn how to work with your personal power in more constructive ways. By embodying the more positive form of your creative energy, and thereby expressing your deepest truth, you can perform an important service for yourself and society.

Important Features

Uranus in Gemini (6° Gem 27'R) Uranus in the Fourth House Ruler of rising sign Uranus in the Fourth House (or sign) gives an eccentric individual with volatile emotions. You may change your residence frequently. You may also feel insecure at times, possibly stemming from a disrupted home life in your early years. Your home life may have been stimulating and challenging, or else there may have been difficulties, perhaps your parents were quite busy with their own affairs, leaving the children out of the picture. You may have difficulty in being sure of yourself, or become focused on your own subconscious process, and have a strong sense of your own unique individuality. You have the zeal to vision new possibilities for tribal connection. You may become interested in the Environmental movement or other ideas related to reinventing the ecological matrix we all live within. You are on the path of transforming your sense of self, creating integration and stability from your own efforts, rather than what comes through from more conventional attitudes of society or your early parental environment.

The following applies to your generation as a whole as well as to you personally:

Mars in Gemini (11° Gem 40'R) Mars in the Fourth House

Mars in the Fourth House (or sign) gives a sensitive, sensuous and emotional nature, gentle and peaceful, with a tendency to internalize conflict. People with this placement of Mars may have trouble with their digestion. You also may need to work through being overly concerned with your private life to the detriment of public enterprise. Your energy is centered on your home environment, and you may spend time and money remodeling or fixing things up just the way you want them around the house. You may appear timid or shy, but are actually quite determined and readily take action although when you do you tend to act from an instinctual level rather than from the basis of your conscious will. You may try too hard to achieve security, or other unconscious goals, and suffer anxiety as a result. Moon in Taurus (9° Tau 13' 11") Moon in the Third House

The Moon in Taurus gives a personality with a deep need for security, centered in the material world. You are possessed of powerful emotions, and you are also charming, good-natured, and attractive. The material world can be of importance to you, for it makes you feel comfortable to be in nice surroundings. You are also very practical, proud and stubborn, and should beware of acting conceited. You are likely to attract a loyal and loving partner.

The Moon in the Third House represents an emotional sensitivity in response to thinking and the intellect. Your mind is ever alert for new information. Your moods are linked with your mental process. You may feel anxiety caused by your habit of constantly questioning the ideas and concepts of the world around you. Each answer you find can be the source of another question for your mind to ponder. Your thinking processes may lack continuity. You are likely to be easily distracted from being able to focus or concentrate. Constant mental activity can lead to a restless nervous system. You dislike routine. Short journeys and personal studies are beneficial to you. You need a variety of stimulation in your mental environment in order to feel comfortable and satisfied.

Sun, Moon, Rising Sign Features

Aquarius Rising

The Rising Sign is the mask shown to others, also the physical appearance.

Sun in strong sextile (within 2.8 degrees) with Ascendant

This aspect between the Sun and the Ascendant gives a strong-willed and generous personality. You are dramatic and assertive, also creative, self-confident and perhaps a bit self-indulgent. Like Leo rising people you expect to be the center of attention, and often are. You have great energy, courage and honesty and are likely to be a natural leader. You can also be inclined to rest on your laurels, relying on your charisma to get you through, rather than spurring yourself on to action. Your challenge is to actualize your great potential.

Mars in strong trine (within 1.2 degrees) with Ascendant

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect gives an active, out-going and self-confident personality. You are daring and have great physical vitality and stamina. You are likely to possess a wiry and spare physique. You are also probably athletic and hard working, perhaps argumentative, and you can definitely "hold your own" in a dispute. You may be so independent that you seem not to care for the opinion of anyone else! Your confidence, independence and will power inspires others. You need physical activity as an outlet for your abundant energy.

Moon in square (within 3.6 degrees) with Ascendant

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect between the Moon and Ascendant gives a nurturing and protective personality. You are subtle in your actions, rather than direct, and are likely to reflect the moods of those around you. Your sense of security and your home are important to you. You have a habit of moodiness, with your emotions frequently changing, and this can create problems in relating to others. You may feel at a loss to connect with others, not being sure of how they really feel towards you, and yet secretly desiring emotional contact with them. You also tend to act instinctively, rather than after reasoning out the situation. You can therefore benefit from shedding the light of conscious reason on your habitual patterns, and working toward greater focus on your true goals.

Pluto in opposition (within 4.3 degrees) with Ascendant

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

With Pluto on your Descendant, you have a predilection for relationship activities and concerns. There is fertile ground for transformation, as well as the possibility for compulsive behavior or power conflicts, all in the area of committed partnership. This aspect gives a willful personality with a focus on being recognized and admired, and this sense of specialness can lead to ego conflicts with partners. The best outcome for this situation would come after long study and resulting growth in understanding of the mechanisms involved. It would be that you become more conscious about the way that you handle the inevitable conflict provided in the context of committed partnership. Other manifestations of this angular Pluto could be that you like to get your way, with strong desires and a single-mindedness about pursuing them. Over time, these deficits can become strengths, once you learn more about the depths of your own psyche. The trial of relationship connection can provide one important mirror for seeing yourself more clearly so that you can transcend potential problematic behavior from the past.

Chiron in inconjunct (within 2.5 degrees) with Ascendant

The planetary energies do not flow smoothly, one or the other predominates; discrimination must be employed.

With this aspect between Chiron and the Ascendant in your chart you are likely to experience painful realizations throughout your own life and have the ability to heal others as well. Chiron is called "the wounded healer" because it represents the archetype of imperfection and loss which when integrated leads to compassion and understanding of others' suffering. The empathy and the understanding that are gained through life's trials provide the ability to serve as a helper and a healer for others. You are more invested in this archetype than most, since Chiron is in a powerful connection with your rising point, symbolizing the self that you present to the world, esoterically your true self. You have probably experienced pain and frustration related to your self-concept, or there could have been trauma in your early years concerning parental protection which may have been withdrawn too suddenly or misapplied, or perhaps similar issues with your peers. These early experiences may have made it hard to accept the love of others in your adult life. Uranus in weak trine (within 6.4 degrees) with Ascendant Ruler of rising sign

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect gives an independent and strong-willed individual. You can be determined to get your own way, and love freedom from conventionality. You like to start new projects, or make major changes in your life, but without completely eliminating previous foundations. You may feel conflicts with the norm, or with others regarding conventional attitudes. You are unpredictable at times, and it can be hard for others to keep up with you. You may have issues with commitment and responsibility. You are an original and independent thinker with an active, scientific mind, futuristic in outlook, and you are capable of bringing new ideas into being. A task that you are ably suited for is to more fully express your visionary impulses to others in order to make these more concretely available in your own life, and in the life of society around you.

Sun in Sagittarius (15° Sag 41' 33") Sun in the Tenth House

The Sun represents your will and purpose, your sense of vitality, and your evolving higher Self. In Sagittarius it is Mutable-Fire, and rules the hips and thighs. Your ruling planet is Jupiter. Sagittarius is an optimistic, positive-thinking sign associated with the quest for freedom from all restriction as well as idealism, religion and philosophy. Sagittarius people are direct and forthright, goodnatured and affirmative in their outlook. You tend to speak with a blunt tongue, which can get you into trouble at times, although you are usually able to laugh yourself out of it. You display honesty and a strong moral nature. You also like to have fun and enjoy a good chuckle, even at your own expense. You gravitate toward adventure, sports and travel, as well as gambling and other forms of risk-taking. You are likely to be very curious about the world around you, with a love for nature and a contagious enthusiasm for exploration of all kinds. At the highest level, you are concerned with understanding, perception, and mental activity in the service of your high ideals for the benefit of mankind.

The Sun in the Tenth House represents a concentration of one's vital force to act with authority and make a responsible contribution to the world. You have a great need to feel accepted and acknowledged by society. Career or vocation is very important to you. You also enjoy the idea of being famous. You may feel yourself to be ambitious, seeking a position of honor, nobility, or leadership. You are likely to personally identify with your career, which could in fact be the underlying reason for seeking status. You may feel more comfortable behind a mask or title than when directly showing yourself to others. You may also closely identify yourself with your mother or opposite sex parent, taking their goals and priorities as your own. Stimulated by your need to receive recognition you are primed to succeed at whatever you choose to do. Your drive, stamina, and commitment generate an aura of calm and collected strength. You are at your best when you are able to fulfill a role from which you can earn respect and gain

insight into your inner motivation, in order to realize your true source of personal power, as you work your way toward your ambitious professional goals.

Sun in strong square (within 0.4 degrees) with Chiron

With this aspect between Sun and Chiron you are likely to experience painful realizations throughout your own life and also have the ability to heal others as well. Chiron is called "the wounded healer" because it represents the archetype of imperfection and loss which when integrated leads to compassion and understanding of others' suffering. The empathy and the understanding that are gained through life's trials provide the ability to serve as a helper and a healer for others. You are more invested in this archetype than most, since it is in a powerful connection with your Sun, representing your conscious self. You have undoubtedly experienced pain and frustration related to your self-concept, perhaps through your relationship with your father or the same-sex parent. There could have been trauma in your early years concerning your parenting or the parental protection that may have been withdrawn too suddenly or misapplied. Sun in bi-quintile (within 0.5 degrees) with Moon

The planetary energies are positively linked, subtle, and spiritual in dimension.

This aspect gives a well-adjusted and stable personality. You proceed with confidence and a sense of well-being to accomplish what you set out to do. You are likely to be healthy, optimistic and popular, and look upon life's problems as challenges to be overcome, rather than as obstacles. You have experienced your parents as harmoniously related, and in your own relationships you expect sound communication and mutual understanding. Your family is important to you. You are poised and cheerful, and your creativity flows freely. It benefits you to overcome complacent or lazy thinking and to rise to the challenge of tackling any problem areas in your life.

Sun in semi-square (within 0.3 degrees) with Venus

The planetary energies conflict in determined subtle tension; calmness is required.

This aspect gives an excitable and emotional personality, with cheerfulness and warm affections. There is usually artistic ability indicated, perhaps in music and dance, as well as a love of refined surroundings. You may appear flighty in your attitudes and your emotions. You are graceful and charming, and are likely to be well-liked.

Sun in opposition (within 4.0 degrees) with Mars

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect gives a rash personality with a quick temper. You are daring and have great physical vitality and stamina, but you may lack patience and tend to be argumentative. You are likely to be restless with a forceful drive that can lead you to accomplish great things, if properly harnessed. You are also likely to be excitable, and tend to run risks. You can be opinionated. You could also be hard to talk with at times, since you have a tendency to take your own position at the expense of another's. You mean well, but it may not turn out that way in the event. You need to temper your strong physical drive with calmness and judgment.

Sun in opposition (within 8.1 degrees) with Saturn

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect gives a deepening and concentration, or a blocking of your self-expression. You are ambitious and may make your mark in the world. There may also be a barrier between you and your self-realization, so that your true feelings are denied outlet. You may be strong-willed, or even autocratic, and can appear selfish, or cautious and reserved. There is usually a sense of rejection or coldness in relationship to your father, and a sense of lack of love in your life, generally, leading to a subconscious desire for recognition. There may be feelings of hostility or a physical ailment that prevents your total participation in life activities. Your heart-center may need developing. The lesson for you is to deepen and broaden the knowledge of who you really are at the level of your innermost soul, and to really learn to love the person that you find in this process.

Sun in opposition (within 9.2 degrees) with Uranus Ruler of rising sign

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect gives an eccentric and strong-willed individual. You can be determined to get your own way, and love freedom from conventionality. You are inclined to be reckless, and may periodically start over in your life, completely eliminating previous foundations. You are likely to rebel against the norm, or conflict with others in this area. Because you are unpredictable at times, it can be hard for others to be comfortable with you. You are an original and independent thinker with an active, scientific mind, futuristic in outlook, and are capable of bringing new ideas into being. You are also inclined to be nervous and impatient, and shy away from commitment and responsibility. You can benefit from striving to control your energetic and visionary impulses in order to make these more concretely available in your own life, and in the life of society around you.

Sun in quintile (within 0.3 degrees) with Neptune

The planetary energies are positively linked, subtle, and spiritual in dimension.

This aspect gives a sensitive and creative individual. You are somewhat unworldly, and are likely to be artistic or musical. You may also be open to mysticism or the exploration of other dimensions through psychic perceptions. You are softhearted, and you may be perhaps even too willing to sacrifice yourself for the good of others. You may find your life's calling in the helping professions, for your compassion is strong. Your aim is to achieve a balance between spiritual dimensions of reality and ordinary life.

Sun in trine (within 7.1 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect gives a willful personality with a focus on being recognized and admired. You have strong desires, and you also have a powerful urge toward self-transformation, and may go through many changes in your life. You are not shy about expressing your beliefs, and you may even feel a compulsion toward self-assertion or self-aggrandizement. You also tend to champion the underdog, and react strongly to social injustice. In relationships, you tend to become intensely involved quickly, and stay absorbed in the relationship as long as it lasts. There may be underlying feelings of insecurity leading to your rather self-centered and ego oriented behavior. Exploring these feelings can be incredibly rewarding for you, and should be quite possible, for you have tremendous powers of regeneration and rebirth. When you learn to train your considerable energy on these socially oriented as well as personal goals, you can become a focal point for the transformation of society itself.

Sun in trine (within 7.5 degrees) with North Node

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

Interpreted natal aspects with North Node are not currently supported.

Moon in strong square (within 0.6 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect gives a moody and introspective personality with a strong desire for emotional security. You are likely to be very sensitive and emotionally intense, with a tendency to become completely absorbed in interpersonal relationships. You are also an extremely forceful individual, with the urge to transform yourself and your surroundings. When you have a goal in mind, nothing will stand in your way. Your need for security may manifest as an almost compulsive desire for a safe and secure home life, or a home environment which can be completely controlled, possibly even through dictatorial behavior. You have an unusually clear insight into the emotional depths of other people, which may border on an actual psychic attunement with their states of being. You also have the urge to break through the limitations of the parental influence you experienced as a child. You may have experienced controlling behavior on the part of one or both parents, especially your mother, and you may find yourself still involved in the battle for your own autonomy many years later. Moon in trine (within 8.3 degrees) with Mercury

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect gives a kindly, sound and logical mentality. You are a good communicator, and are able to express your emotions easily. You are an inquisitive student of life, and are also excellent at working with the public. You usually prefer plain and direct speech, and you are judicious and honest in your approach to life.

Moon in opposition (within 8.8 degrees) with Venus

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect gives you a somewhat difficult personality. You are kind and artistically gifted, but you may be hard to live with. You dislike having to act charming in social situations when you may not really feel it, and you have a reluctance to come forward into relationship with others, although you have a good deal of charm when you allow yourself to express it, and can be very popular socially. You may encounter sadness in your life as a result of close personal relationships that go astray. You also may spend your money unwisely, and may need to cultivate more respect for its value.

Moon in semi-sextile (within 2.5 degrees) with Mars

The planetary energies attract each other, require effort, allow entry of new information.

This aspect gives an individual who is easily influenced by emotional conditions. You can be a deep thinker, but you may be intolerant of opinions other than your own. You may appear selfish and demanding at times. You may suffer from a sort of nervous tension, in that you are unsatisfied when you are not in action. You also have a rebellious streak that affects your close personal relationships. You are an analytical and independent thinker with an original, active and even brilliant mind.

Moon in semi-square (within 0.5 degrees) with Saturn

The planetary energies conflict in determined subtle tension; calmness is required.

This aspect gives a deepening and concentrating, or a blockage in the expression of your feelings. You may seem to be rigid, rather letting your emotions flow freely, stemming from problems with parental care and guidance in your early years. You can be extremely sensitive and may experience some difficulties in your relationship to the feminine. The lesson for you here is to understand and value your origins more fully, leading to a better sense of security and greater self-acceptance.

Moon in semi-sextile (within 2.8 degrees) with Uranus Ruler of rising sign

The planetary energies attract each other, require effort, allow entry of new information.

This aspect gives an eccentric personality with volatile emotions and with a strong sense of intuition. You have changeable emotions, and may appear unpredictable, at times, to other people. Novelty excites you. You may change your residence frequently, or go through fundamental transformations of identity in your life, and you may feel stifled if these impulses are not allowed expression. You can benefit from learning to balance your needs for security with your urge for freedom and experimentation.

Moon in inconjunct (within 5.2 degrees) with Neptune

The planetary energies do not flow smoothly, one or the other predominates; discrimination must be employed.

This aspect gives an emotionally sensitive, idealistic and loving personality. You possess an ethereal quality, and are likely to be imaginative or even to withdraw from the world into internal fantasies of your own. You may have powerful psychic abilities. You are the softhearted type, and you are perhaps even too willing to sacrifice yourself for the good of others. You were probably strongly influenced by your home life, and may tend to idealize these formative experiences. You could have issues with self-deception or experience discontent with the practical realities of life for the urge within you to seek the highest ideal is very strong. Your home is important to you, and you may change residences frequently in search of your ideal environment, or dream of the ideal romantic attachment without ever finding the perfect mate. You benefit from striving for greater self-control in holding back your emotions, as well as clarity in applying your high ideals to the real world of logic and fact.

Moon in trine (within 6.1 degrees) with Chiron

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

With this aspect there are difficulties indicated in relating to the feminine either significant female presences in your life or else and including your own feminine side. This would be true, and different in its sense, in either a man's or a woman's chart. Of course the important early model for the feminine is mother, and it is likely that you have a deep and intense relationship with your mother, which may have been productive of much wisdom. There also may be emotional scars from the very intensity of your experience together. These experiences may be so painful that they become suppressed from consciousness, buried deep in your psyche. In your adult life, it is important to move past any resentment you still feel, caused by early wounding in your relationship with the female part, or nurturing influence, of your own nature, so that you can begin to move into a more conscious and compassionate reconciliation with your walled off parts. Once you have begun to make conscious any pain and alienation you may feel surrounding events from the long-buried past, you can begin to truly help others as well as yourself. A creative side of your nature may emerge like a butterfly out of the outgrown past.

The ruler of your Sun Sign is Jupiter in Leo (27° Leo 01')

The ruler of your Sun sign is characteristic of your personality:

Jupiter in the Seventh House (or sign) gives you a refined and idealistic nature. You are easily influenced by others, and may have great difficulty in making a decision, especially when you start to take into consideration all of the possibilities that suggest themselves to you. You work well with other

Jupiter in Leo (or the fifth house) gives you a generous personality with good vitality. You have dignity, pride and dramatic presence, and are courageous in your sense of self. You are likely to be a loyal companion. You possess excellent executive abilities. You like to show off your good side, and have a natural flair and sense of showmanship that carries you far in life. You enjoy the limelight, and would always rather shine out on a hillside than hide your light under a barrel. You are attracted to higher learning, and the fine arts, including the theater, and may try your hand at acting. You can also be extravagant at times, or suffer from errors in judgment. You may tend to overdo, and need to beware of egotism. You have good intuition; you make a capable leader when you follow your own inner guidelines.

Uranus in strong sextile (within 2.1 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

This combination gives an individual who is willful and possesses great depth of passion. This is a generational aspect, which many of your contemporaries will share with you. You are to an unusual degree tuned in to the energy of the collective, especially with regard to the ultimate transformation of society. You have a keen intuition and great power to transform yourself and your personal relationships as you evolve. You may have an unconventional approach where sexual matters are concerned, or with interpersonal relationships (especially when Pluto makes close aspects to 'personal' planets in your chart). At your best, you are compassionate toward your fellow man, and you are apt to be a helper in the creation of a new world, based on humanitarian ideals of universal brotherhood.

Uranus in strong sextile (within 1.8 degrees) with North Node

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

Interpreted natal aspects with North Node are not currently supported.

Venus in bi-quintile (within 0.1 degrees) with Uranus

The planetary energies are positively linked, subtle, and spiritual in dimension.

This aspect gives an individual who is independent and original in the expression of social activities and in relationships. You enjoy the excitement of new contacts. You have a creative attitude that may express itself through artistic endeavors. You are also tolerant and accepting of other people. You may be unconventional in your attitudes and you tend to occupy yourself with multiple interests and explorations. You can benefit from attempting to bring a steady and consistent focus to your many interests and activities.

Mars in conjunction (within 5.2 degrees) with Uranus

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

This conjunction gives an individual with an original and eccentric mind, whose intuition is strong. You are a strong-willed nonconformist, and totally have your own code of ethics. You are energetic and visionary in your outlook. You may be rebellious at times, or display fits of temper. You can be quite rash and impulsive. You are also restless and may lack steadiness in the pursuit of your goals. You may feel a sense of isolation, and can appear emotionally insensitive at times, seemingly more excited by ideas than by other people. Your basis for action derives from a sense of high ideals, rather than from mere egotism. You also could beware, however, of a tendency to be dogmatic, or proud and unbending. Change and variety excite you, and your mutability and urge for constant change can frustrate or confuse those around you. In essence, you are a courageous and pioneering free spirit, whose mission in life is to bring new ideas into being. You can benefit from bringing more consciousness and clarity to the expression of your goals in life.

Uranus in trine (within 2.4 degrees) with Neptune

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect gives a future oriented and idealistic individual, very aware of collective energies. This is a generational aspect, which many of your contemporaries will share with you. You may feel a pull to the service of humanity at large. You are likely to be interested in mysticism and the occult. You may also be inclined to nervousness (especially if Uranus makes close aspects to the personal planets in your chart). You may feel some sense of confinement or restriction in the freedom to be who you want to be. Social ideals will strongly affect the expression of your individuality.

Other Natal Planets

Mercury in Capricorn (0° Cap 53') Mercury in the Eleventh House Mercury in Capricorn gives a serious, practical and detached mentality. With this placement you have a diplomatic bent, and also make a good teacher. You are determined and careful in your speech and communication with others, as well as in your own mental activity. You tend to be acutely aware of your surroundings. You can help keep others on track with the reality of what is going on. You have good concentration and attention to detail. You can also be somewhat intolerant. You benefit from lifting your vision to the higher issue and cultivating idealism.

Mercury in the Eleventh House represents a strong mental connection between your inner awareness and that of others, in friendships or in the setting of group associations. Your social motivation is strong, and you strive in your communication and contact with others to advance the cause of humanitarian ideals. You also have an inquisitive and scientific mind, with excellent powers of logic and reason, and an insightful and detached mentality. Your thinking is idealistic, yet also well grounded in reality. You are a good judge of character, and you appreciate the beauty of things in the world, but not apart from their utility and ultimate purpose. You enjoy learning in the company of others who share your interests and curiosities. You are in tune with how people within a collective share and integrate ideas. You are a natural conduit for group awareness, and may find yourself a leader in facilitating group dynamics. You benefit when you can grow and express yourself within the context of larger group or collective.

Venus in Scorpio (0° Sco 23') Venus in the Ninth House

Venus in Scorpio gives a fervent and intense love nature that has the possibility of being obsessive or self-involved at times. This placement may prove difficult for you, because the intense passions of Scorpio can be more than the milder love energy of Venus is ready for. You are sensual and passionate in relationship, and tend to relate to even casual contacts on a deeper and more personal level. For you, there is no such thing as a superficial contact with others. You also may feel a basic relationship insecurity that drives you to be possessive or even jealous at times. You may appear friendly on the surface while acting selfishly at another more hidden level of your personality. You benefit from curbing the obsessive expression of your will. Your challenge is the transformation of your deep and all consuming passion into a more open and caring relationship energy.

Venus in the Ninth House represents a strong connection within you between your sense of aesthetics, including what you value, and higher mind, philosophy or religion. You are drawn to higher learning, and to the spiritual principles underlying belief systems. You may be attracted to philosophical structures that express the fundamental idea of right living and right relationship. You are also drawn to the learning that comes from contact with other cultures. You have an affectionate personality, with good intuition. You tend to be idealistic in your approach to love, and also changeable in the expression of your love interest, seeking the adventure of new connections. You are a perpetual learner, with a love of exploring through travel and other means of broadening your horizons, and you may feel called to educational pursuits as a way to express your enthusiasm. If

you are inclined to self-expression in the arts it may be regarding these more philosophically active areas, in written, spoken or graphical form.

Saturn in Gemini (23° Gem 45'R) Saturn in the Fifth House

Saturn in the Fifth House (or sign) gives a deepening and concentration, or a blockage, in the capacity for self-expression. There may seem to be a barrier between you and your self-realization, so that your true feelings are denied outlet. Expressing yourself is very important to you, and if you believe yourself to be inadequate in this area, you may feel that you have to try all the harder for recognition. You are likely to be strong-willed and autocratic, and can also appear selfish, or cautious and reserved. Your heart-center may need developing. There may be a sense of a lack of love in your life, and a subconscious desire for acceptance that manifests as rigidity, doubt and insecurity. You may even develop a physical ailment that prevents total participation in life activities. Your lesson is to make contact with your own inner significance by deepening and particularizing the knowledge of who you really are, to discover your true self, and learn to love the person you uncover in the process.

Neptune in Libra (4° Lib 01') Neptune in the Eighth House

Neptune in the Eighth House (or sign) gives an individual with great personal magnetism. You have a subtle intuition and an unusually clear insight into the motivations of others. You also may unconsciously try to control other people, or act in somewhat unreliable ways. You have an ideal of self-sacrifice in partnership with others, and tend to give more than you receive, which can lead in the end to resentment on your part, or just disappearing. Otherworldly affairs may interest you more than everyday ones, and you may be drawn to psychic matters or occult studies. Your dreams are very important to you, and through them you may learn significant information. You are likely to possess an enjoyment of sensual pleasures or luxuries. You may also have some confusion regarding

sexuality and with what you truly desire from relationships. You benefit from bringing greater clarity to your personal values, your relation to the material world and to other people.

The following applies to your generation as a whole as well as to you personally:

You are imaginative and visionary. You may feel a sense of obligation to other people and can give a great deal without expecting anything in return. You dream of finding the perfect partner, but you may encounter difficulties in making that dream a reality. There can be emotional confusion, leading you to depend too much on the strength of another person. You may unconsciously seek a partner with dependency issues, like drug or alcohol or fantasy addiction, as a mirror for your own inner lack of clarity. You also may seek in your partner a sense of rising above the merely mundane, which can be very appealing to you. There are likely to be karmic lessons for you in regard to partnership and marriage. Making an effort to pull back from too much self-sacrifice can bring greater clarity to relationships, which can be of benefit to all concerned.

N Node in Leo (8° Leo 13'R) N Node in the Sixth House

Lunar North Node in the Sixth House (or sign). South Node in the twelfth house or sign. This placement gives a personality with a great desire to be of service to other people. In the past, or in past lives, you were dreamy and unfocused, and paid little attention to detail. You were in the process of connecting to your higher self, journeying back into the cosmic realms within your own mind. Now your focus must shift to the details of daily life, in a constant effort to improve self, to serve self and others, and to remain alert to the myriad mundane details of life that do not leave much time for day dreaming. This is a difficult transition to make, but necessary if you are to fulfill your destiny, this time around. As your life unfolds, you may find that issues of health may come up for you, in order for you to work through them. You may possibly be called to care for another whose illness will be a test of your patience and your commitment to service. Since you feel a close kinship to the spiritual world, dealing with every-day details sometimes may seem boring and unsatisfying. As you work through these challenges, though, you come closer and closer to an understanding of how dealing with every-day issues really does connect you with the world of Spirit, still operating at the core of your being.

Lunar North Node in Leo (or the fifth house). South Node in the eleventh house or sign. This placement gives a personality with a focus on being recognized and admired for the personal creativity that you manifest. You are fortunate in this lifetime, for few people have the capacity, as you do, of actually making your dreams come true. You are engaged in a life-long process of concretizing your thought images, turning the products of your extraordinarily clever intellect into actual manifestation in the world. In the past, or in past lifetimes, you specialized in ideals and imaginings, without

giving much thought to working these out in the real world. But as you get on with your life's journey you find that actually manifesting these thought forms becomes more and more your focus. When you are on your true path, you find that you must act and create, for in acting you give form to the otherwise formless and ideal, and in so doing fulfill your destiny.

Ceres in Cancer (4° Can 59'R) Ceres in the Fifth House

Ceres is the first asteroid that was ever discovered, on New Year's Day of 1801, and it remains the largest. It was named for the Roman earth goddess of grain and the harvest. The Greek name for this earth goddess is Demeter. As goddess of the harvest and the natural process of fertility and renewal, Ceres represents in an individual chart the process of nurturing as well as motherhood, and has been experimentally attributed to the sign Cancer as a co-ruler with the Moon, as well as to the sign of Virgo where there is growing agreement among modern Western astrologers that she should be placed. All four major asteroids could be considered as co-ruling Virgo, and they all seem to represent different aspects of the feminine, and therefore could be thought of as further refinements of the lunar principle. An afflicted Ceres, by position or by planetary aspect, may indicate problems with being able to nurture, or to be nurtured by others. This could manifest in food complexes, or a feeling of rejection by parental figures. When strongly placed, she symbolizes the ability to take on parental responsibilities, especially in a female subject, and also may indicate someone who has a close relationship with the earth, as a gardener or grower of food. Also the position of Ceres by house and sign, and its planetary connections, is likely to indicate the way in which motherhood (or parenthood) manifests in the life of the individual.

The Fifth House represents creativity and self-expression, also offspring, and is also associated with romance and affection. Following the base of operations represented by the fourth, the fifth house represents the arena in which your personal energies can be released into the world. Any area stamped by your personality, including the display of affection or any creative endeavors such as your artistic expression, is therefore represented by planets in the Fifth House or the sign on the Fifth House cusp.

Pallas in Aries (5° Ari 01') Pallas in the Second House

The asteroid Pallas (short for Pallas Athene) was found in 1802, the second of the four major asteroids to be discovered. The four major asteroids, Ceres, Pallas, Juno and Vesta, were discovered within a few years of each other at the beginning of the 19th century, and named for female goddesses in the Roman pantheon. Their discovery has been synchronous with the rise of the women's movement in the West. These four asteroids seem to symbolize four different facets of the feminine and represent a fresh way of regarding the feminine principle in astrology, going beyond the relatively simple categories of wife and mother, as represented by Venus and the Moon. Pallas represents the wisdom of the female spirit, as the mythology of Pallas Athene would indicate: born from the head of Zeus,

and symbolized by the owl and the snake, Pallas Athene was a powerful symbol for independence and wisdom in the ancient mythology. She did not ally herself with any man, but rather was a strong and warrior-like figure who aided men of good will and whose advice was prized for its intelligence. The astrology of the asteroid Pallas indicates such a feminine spirit of independence and cool mental judgment in either a man's or a woman's chart. Pallas represents the creative use of the mental faculty in combination with ageless wisdom, and is also involved with the arts, especially the plastic arts such as sculpture and pottery, and with medicinal remedies. Its position by house and sign indicates where in one's life the divine spark of creative intelligence and higher wisdom may spring forth.

The Second House symbolizes what the self has to work with materially: possessions, money, and physical resources. This house also represents your desires and values. Planets in the Second House operate in the field of material needs and also indicate what you value most highly.

Juno in Aquarius (4° Aqu 57') Juno in the Twelfth House

The asteroid Juno was found in 1805, and was the third of the four major asteroids to be discovered. These four asteroids, which came on the scene just as the 19th century began, represent different aspects of the feminine spirit. In mythology Juno (or the Greek Hera) was wife and consort to Jupiter, and therefore the astrology of Juno represents the partnering energy of intimate relationship. This is also the territory of Venus and the Moon, but where Juno seems to differ is in representing the partnership energy in a new light, as in confronting the more modern issues of where the boundaries are with another person, how much sharing is appropriate, versus holding back, as well as how to deal with bitterness and jealousy, or projected authority and control that is thrown onto another person. Juno also stands for intimacy needs in general. When Juno is prominent in a natal chart, all these type of issues are important to the individual, and if Juno is aspected by another planet, these issues may be colored by the energy of that planet. Juno's position by house and sign is an indication of the area of life in which these issues will be most important.

The Twelfth House refers to the unconscious and to things beyond the physical plane. It is traditionally associated with confinement and self-undoing, and has been called the house of karma. Planets in this house indicate functions that are hidden from your conscious personality, and are expressed in terms of psychic faculty or self-sacrifice.

Vesta in Gemini (10° Gem 59'R) Vesta in the Fourth House

The asteroid Vesta was the last of the four major asteroids to be discovered, in 1807. The mythology of Vesta (or Greek Hestia) is as follows: one of the sisters of Jupiter and Juno, Vesta chose to remain a virgin and not marry. She was the goddess of the hearth fire, which was of utmost importance in ancient times, connoting hospitality and the basic vitality of the home or city-state, and her astrological symbol is the flame. It is interesting to note that Vesta is the brightest of the four asteroids. Her

symbolism also suggests the "vestal virgin" temple priestesses of the ancient Greek world, and their commitment to no man, but rather to their own inner flame of service to the goddess. Their service might even be of a sexual nature, but they remained untouched by any sexual intimacy with another person. In accordance with its mythology, the asteroid Vesta is therefore involved with the signs Virgo and Scorpio. In the astrology of Vesta in an individual chart, these issues of sexuality and completeness unto oneself predominate. Possible associations are the woman (or man) who chooses not to mate, but just as a nun or monk, takes on a higher purpose than normal family life. Vesta may also bring up issues of sexuality and of who is ultimately served in the process, self or other. When Vesta is prominent in the chart, there may be issues with purity, singleness and sexuality either through abstinence or by involving oneself with multiple partners which yet leave the individual untouched by relationship. The placement of Vesta by house and sign also indicate the area of life where these types of issues may manifest.

The Fourth House represents the home environment, family life, and the father, or perhaps the same sex parent. As the base of operations of the personality this house is quite important, because without a place to stand emotionally, the personality cannot function. Planets in the Fourth House reflect your family orientation, an ability to dig into the past in order to discover the roots of your being, and how your father (or perhaps your mother) was experienced.

Other Aspects

Mercury in strong sextile (within 0.5 degrees) with Venus

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

This aspect gives a charming manner and an idealistic philosophy. You are friendly and sociable, and lean toward the beautiful and artistic side of life. You have artistic abilities and a youthful attitude, and tend to like young people. You like to dress attractively, although not necessarily expensively, and are likely to be cheerful and optimistic. You also usually have a pleasant speaking or singing voice, and express yourself well in speech or writing. You can be very persuasive in a quiet way.

Mars in strong conjunction (within 0.7 degrees) with Vesta

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

Interpreted natal aspects with Vesta are not currently supported.

Jupiter in strong square (exact) with Midheaven

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect gives a positive and optimistic personality. You are lucky and are likely to be successful at whatever you strive for. You have an expansive attitude toward new projects, so that there can be too much growth potential for you to handle. You need to get a reality check from time to time. You have good spirits and are able to see the big picture, so that others find you an inspiration to be around, but you may have to beware of too much complacency and self-satisfaction. You benefit from cultivating humility in your dealings with other people.

Uranus in strong sextile (within 1.4 degrees) with Pallas

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

This conjunction gives a quiet and unassuming and clever personality, which is also somewhat scattered. You are good-natured, and are likely to be above average in intelligence. You likely prefer a simple mode of life and possess a good balance between spiritual and physical realms.

Mercury in square (within 3.1 degrees) with Neptune

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect gives a clever and imaginative personality with subtle charm. You are visionary and poetic, and quite possibly possess great personal magnetism. You are likely to be an inspired thinker, and may excel in literary accomplishments, especially poetry or fantasy, or perhaps in the visual arts. With a strong connection between your conscious and unconscious mind, you think in terms of symbols rather than logical connections. You are fond of education, but you may miss out on serious study because of your dreaminess and lack of focus. Your imagination is strong, almost to the point of deception; you may tend to confuse illusions with reality, or over-glamorize the object of your ideals. You can profit from learning greater discrimination in your thought process, which will allow you to reap the full benefit and inspiration of your marvelous gift.

Mercury in opposition (within 4.1 degrees) with Ceres

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

Interpreted natal aspects with Ceres are not currently supported.

Mercury in square (within 4.1 degrees) with Pallas

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

Interpreted natal aspects with Pallas are not currently supported.

Venus in sextile (within 3.4 degrees) with Jupiter

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

This aspect gives a refined and idealistic nature. You always see the big picture but may miss out on the practicalities along the way. You are incredibly optimistic, and see opportunity in everything. You may therefore

suffer from a lack of focus, and not knowing what you really want. You are perhaps too easily influenced by others, and may have difficulty in making decisions. You are a great lover of art and beauty, and are very social and attractive.

Venus in semi-square (within 0.1 degrees) with Chiron

The planetary energies conflict in determined subtle tension; calmness is required.

This combination gives a personality that experiences difficulties with relationships. You are likely to have had painful experiences surrounding marriage and intimate partnerships, but there are also great rewards to be gained in this area. You are drawn to relationship at the same time that you fear it, so that you may also have a strong focus on forming close emotional attachments. You may have had early childhood experiences that made it hard to accept the love of others in your adult life. With these distractions, you also may strongly desire to help other people, and yet be unable to give them the full benefit of your higher self. It is good to make the effort to connect yourself consciously with any painful events that may be buried in your unconscious, so that these will no longer have so much power over you. Once you have begun to integrate these painful feelings consciously, and shed the baggage of earlier frustrations, you can be a more fully participating partner to others, and be more of help to them as well.

Venus in trine (within 4.6 degrees) with Ceres

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

Interpreted natal aspects with Ceres are not currently supported.

Venus in square (within 4.6 degrees) with Juno

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

Mars in sextile (within 3.1 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

This aspect gives a personality with a tremendous drive for power and transformation of self. You are strong-willed almost to the point of ruthlessness, and you have enormous energy and endurance at your disposal. You may appear timid or unsure of yourself, since the power urge is commonly repressed, but then there is the potential for sudden bursts of anger due to the repressed emotion finally exploding to the surface. You

may also have feelings of insecurity that are compensated for by being overly forceful, acting compulsively or even becoming obsessive about achieving your will. In a more positive manifestation, you can exhibit a dedication to higher ideals and a willingness to be a channel for healing yourself and society. The challenge is movement away from feelings of insecurity and resulting separateness and loneliness, toward a better acceptance of other's needs and opinions in order to generate wholeness, forgiveness towards self and others, and a new and better sense of self-worth.

Mars in square (within 3.7 degrees) with Chiron

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

With this aspect you have issues around expressing anger, as well as exerting personal will versus knuckling under to authority. You have enormous energy and endurance at your disposal, although you may appear timid or unsure of yourself, since your power urge is likely to be repressed. It may be that you have had many painful experiences with violence, or potential violence, on the part of someone close to you, perhaps in your early childhood. As a result of these experiences, you may fear the power of your own anger, and seek to placate your opponent in situations where a direct confrontation seems to be brewing. This aspect is the hallmark of a "passive-aggressive" attitude, in which there is hidden aggression under-expressed, rather than any form of direct attack. In fact, it is said that those with this aspect are often very good at eliciting angry behavior from others, while their own hands stay clean. This is because those people you come into close contact with may become the projection point for your own hidden violent feelings that you are failing to directly express yourself. It is often the case that the powerful emotions associated with this aspect hover below the level of conscious awareness in your psyche. As you become more aware of these patterns, you will less and less need to act them out either suppressed with passivity, or with bluster. Another manifestation of this aspect, perhaps paradoxically, is the ability to lead and be willful, to not take "no for an answer", to be ruthless in accomplishing one's aims. The willful energy of Mars is given a creative boost by Chiron, both in terms of suffering and in a better-integrated personality, in terms of conquest. A still better level of integration produces the self-assured and powerful personality who does not depend on others either to express his or her own desires, nor to be crushed by them.

Mars in sextile (within 3.5 degrees) with North Node

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

Interpreted natal aspects with North Node are not currently supported.

Jupiter in sextile (within 3.3 degrees) with Saturn

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

This aspect gives a serious and conscientious personality. You are strong morally, and likely to be socially active. You are quietly ambitious with a good sense about you that impresses other people. You make an excellent manager, and have a strong drive to achieve success, with a talent for working with the public. You desire to be a force for good in society. If you live up to this ideal, you will be a natural leader, being optimistic, yet practical, and possessing excellent judgment. For the early part of your life you may tend to hide your light under a basket; your powers are likely to grow as you mature.

Jupiter in septile (within 0.6 degrees) with Ceres

The planetary energies darkly interact; incline to occult dimensions apart from socially accepted norms.

Interpreted natal aspects with Ceres are not currently supported.

Saturn in semi-square (within 0.2 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies conflict in determined subtle tension; calmness is required.

This aspect gives a forceful personality with a focus on issues of authority, power and control. You may have a compulsion for control leading to problems with interpersonal relations or rebellious attitudes toward established authority. What is needed is a re-evaluation and transformation of the urge for power and control, based on a deeper understanding of and more conscious and socially responsible use of personal power.

Saturn in semi-square (within 0.5 degrees) with North Node

The planetary energies conflict in determined subtle tension; calmness is required.

Interpreted natal aspects with North Node are not currently supported.

Saturn in inconjunct (within 3.2 degrees) with Midheaven

The planetary energies do not flow smoothly, one or the other predominates; discrimination must be employed.

You are persistent and thorough, and may be careful or calculating in your dealings with others. This aspect gives an ambitious and clear-minded individual, with a strong sense of responsibility. You may suffer from feelings of inferiority. You are likely to have had problems in the early life with finding your own identity, independent of parental figures, so that in your adult life you may operate out of a subconscious fear that if you don't

conquer the world first, then it will conquer you instead. You also may have difficulties, limitations or delays in the achievement of your goals, but you are likely to achieve success in the end through your tremendous drive to achieve.

Uranus in semi-sextile (within 1.5 degrees) with Ceres

The planetary energies attract each other, require effort, allow entry of new information.

Interpreted natal aspects with Ceres are not currently supported.

Uranus in conjunction (within 4.5 degrees) with Vesta

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

Interpreted natal aspects with Vesta are not currently supported.

Neptune in sextile (within 4.6 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

This combination gives an individual with a personal involvement in the energies of the collective. This is a generational aspect, which many of your contemporaries will share with you. You have a subtle intuition and unusually clear insight into others. The influence of the unconscious is especially strong in you. You need to connect with your higher self in order to be happy. You function at your best in service to the world, helping to move it closer to a vision of spiritual union between all mankind.

Neptune in sextile (within 4.2 degrees) with North Node

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

Pluto in trine (within 3.6 degrees) with Pallas

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

Pluto in opposition (within 3.6 degrees) with Juno

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

Interpreted natal aspects with Juno are not currently supported.

Pluto in sextile (within 2.4 degrees) with Vesta

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

Interpreted natal aspects with Vesta are not currently supported.

Chiron in quintile (within 0.4 degrees) with Midheaven

The planetary energies are positively linked, subtle, and spiritual in dimension.

With this aspect of Chiron and your Midheaven, you may have issues around exerting personal will versus knuckling under to authority. As a result of experiences you have had with authority, you may somewhat fear the expression of your own personal power, and alternate between complying with the standards of society around you, or rebelling against them. You may also avoid situations where a direct confrontation seems to be brewing. You may feel more empowered in helping others than in getting your own act together, and this aspect can be the sign of someone with a career in the helping professions, perhaps involved with new age healing. When you have achieved a better level of integration, so that you do not depend on others either to fully express your own desires, nor to be swayed by theirs, and have integrated the walled-off places in your psyche that inhibit action on the part of your whole entire self, you are more available to yourself in situations of leadership, as well as in truly helping other people.

Chiron in quintile (within 1.7 degrees) with Ceres

The planetary energies are positively linked, subtle, and spiritual in dimension.

Interpreted natal aspects with Ceres are not currently supported.

Chiron in square (within 4.3 degrees) with Vesta

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

N Node in opposition (within 4.7 degrees) with Ascendant

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

N Node in trine (within 3.2 degrees) with Pallas

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

Interpreted natal aspects with Pallas are not currently supported.

N Node in opposition (within 3.3 degrees) with Juno

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

Interpreted natal aspects with Juno are not currently supported.

N Node in sextile (within 2.8 degrees) with Vesta

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

Interpreted natal aspects with Vesta are not currently supported.

Ceres in inconjunct (exact) with Juno

The planetary energies do not flow smoothly, one or the other predominates; discrimination must be employed.

Interpreted natal aspects with Juno are not currently supported.

Pallas in sextile (within 6.0 degrees) with Vesta

The planetary energies flow together, open into new possibilities, new connections.

Interpreted natal aspects with Vesta are not currently supported.

Juno in trine (within 6.0 degrees) with Vesta

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

Interpreted natal aspects with Vesta are not currently supported.

Sun in weak trine (within 11.3 degrees) with Jupiter

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect gives an optimistic and generous individual, with good spirits and abundant energy. You are quietly spiritual in your approach to life. You also have good executive abilities, and make a capable leader. You are

fortunate materially, and have simple tastes, so that your wants are few and easily satisfied. Good fortune follows you through life.

Sun in weak trine (within 10.7 degrees) with Pallas

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

Interpreted natal aspects with Pallas are not currently supported.

Mercury in weak opposition (within 7.1 degrees) with Saturn

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect gives a profound mentality, deepening and concentrating your mind and your powers of speech and communication. You are shrewd in business, and are adaptable to a variety of professions. Long hours of concentration could produce in you a brilliant scholar, or a star of the legal profession. You may seem to suffer from a variety of nervous disorders, but these could actually be the result of subconscious fears of inadequacy in mental pursuits. You may on the other hand over-compensate for this by making extraordinary efforts. You may also feel a sense of isolation and loneliness in your life. Your lesson is to learn faith and to cultivate a positive attitude toward your mental process, restructuring that process along more personal and less rigid lines.

Venus in weak trine (within 6.6 degrees) with Saturn

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect gives a personality with a deepening and concentration in the area of interpersonal relationships. You are sensitive and have a strong sense of duty. You are likely to be loyal, cautious and reserved. You do not involve yourself quickly in relations with others, having a judicious sense of the proper timing of such activities. You also make an excellent businessperson, as you are possessed of good judgment diplomacy and tact, and are outer directed and self-reliant. You may feel a sense of isolation and loneliness in your life, or a tendency to substitute material rewards for love and caring. You could also have fears of rejection concerning romantic contacts. Yet you have also the opportunity to rise above these circumstances in concentrated effort over time. By being open to the path of relationship you can move toward inner integration and balance, toward relationship more fully explored and felt, based on a renewed self-confidence born of actual experience and mutual understanding.

Venus in weak square (within 8.2 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

This aspect gives a magnetic personality with a focus on forming close emotional attachments. You are charismatic and intense, and seek to break through any barriers to close interpersonal relationships, although you may be difficult to satisfy emotionally. You may experience misfortune in marriage and partnerships, but there are also great rewards to be gained in this area. You can become involved in power struggles with partners, or act in a manipulative way towards other people, which problems are made more poignant since you also may have a compulsion to be liked by others. You have simultaneously an attraction toward close involvement with another person, together with fears regarding such involvements. There are some extreme difficulties to be worked out in these areas, which may lead you to a painful re-examination of your goals. Wisdom is required in the way you handle close relationships, in order to transform the partnership energy into a growing and conscious act of sharing.

Venus in weak square (within 7.8 degrees) with North Node

The planetary energies conflict; internal and creative tensions bring rich rewards through effort over time.

Interpreted natal aspects with North Node are not currently supported.

Mars in weak trine (within 7.7 degrees) with Neptune

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect gives an attractive personality with a strong psychic sensitivity and an inclination to mysticism and the arts. You possess a good understanding of and balance between the practical and the ideal. You have a personal magnetism that can strongly influence other people. You are able to create images in the minds of others. You are very creative, and also very tolerant and understanding. You are likely to be quite sensitive to the needs of others, and may have the talent of a natural healer. You can also be vague regarding your own motivation or fall into periods of discontent with life in the material plane. You can benefit from clarifying your aims, and learning to focus your power and become a channel for its higher use in your life and that of society around you.

Mars in weak trine (within 6.7 degrees) with Juno

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

Interpreted natal aspects with Juno are not currently supported.

Neptune in weak trine (within 7.0 degrees) with Vesta

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

Interpreted natal aspects with Vesta are not currently supported.

Glossary

Ascendant

The point in the sky of the Eastern horizon. In the chart, the Ascendant is represented by the horizontal line at the left hand side of the chart which crosses between the Twelfth and First Houses. The sign on the Ascendant is also referred to as the Rising Sign.

Aspects

When the relative positions of two planets in the horoscope form a significant angle with each other, they are said to be in aspect with one another. The type and quality of the aspect is determined by the number of degrees between the two planets and is only considered significant if it is within a narrow range of degrees, or orb. A list of the most commonly used aspects is given below.

Conjunction: 0 degrees
Opposition: 180 degrees
Square: 90 degrees
Sextile: 60 degrees
Trine: 120 degrees
Inconjunct: 150 degrees

Chart Comparison

An astrological technique in which the planets of two individuals are shown in a bi-wheel chart, one within the other. This allows the inter-aspects between the two charts to be examined.

Composite Chart

An astrological technique in which the midpoints of two individuals' planetary positions are used to create a third chart, the composite chart, which is then interpreted as the chart of the relationship itself as an independent entity.

Horoscope

Originally horoscope referred to the astrological chart itself, but is now popularly used to refer to the description of how current planetary positions are affecting you personally, as in 'your monthly horoscope.'

Midheaven

The point in the sky directly overhead relative to the position on Earth. In the chart, the Midheaven is represented by the vertical line at the top of the chart between the Ninth and Tenth Houses.

Natal

From Latin, meaning of or pertaining to birth; therefore your birth chart, or planetary positions at birth.

Lunar Nodes

The Lunar Nodes are the two points where the Moon's orbital path crosses the plane of the ecliptic (the plane of the Earth's orbit around the Sun). Symbolically they represent talents and life path, or destiny.

Planets

In astrology, the word planets is used to describe astrologically significant points in the sky which includes the Sun and Moon, as well as many objects that are not currently astronomically defined as planets such as Chiron and Pluto.

Transits

Aspects formed between the current positions of the planets and the positions of your natal planets at the time and place you were born.
